As a teacher and performer, I have many years of experience and I teach in a number of local primary and secondary schools, working both as a private teacher and also for West Sussex Music Trust. Whether a student wishes just to play for pleasure, take instrumental music exams, requires help with the performance elements of their GCSE music exam or is considering a career as a musician, I am there to support and encourage them.

From September 2024 my lesson fees are:

£8.00 per group recorder lesson*

£9.00 per group flute/clarinet or saxophone lesson *

£16.00 per 20-minute individual lesson

*group lessons are up usuallu between 2 – 4 children and only available if another person from the same year group wants to learn

I will invoice parents directly at the beginning of each half term.

Terms and Conditions for Music Tuition with Sarah Grose

1. Tuition will usually be given in a course of 12 - 14 weekly lessons per term. (they will generally correspond to the amount of weeks in a school term)

2. Fees for will be invoiced on a half-termly basis, to be paid by the payment due date which is shown on each invoice. They can either be paid directly into my account by BACS*, by cash or by cheque or which can be brought to the first lesson of term or posted to my home address.

(* For BACS payment my bank account details: Sarah Grose (Personal account)

3. Lessons cancelled by the teacher. In this situation I will always try to make up for the cancelled lesson by supplying the missed lesson on a different day/week, offering a double lesson/extra time or holding the lesson over into the next term. Where this is not possible a credit will be raised.

4. Lessons missed by the students: Non-attendance will be charged for, except for special reasons such as prolonged illness or if in the teacher's opinion it warrants a special concession.

5. Notice to discontinue lessons – please give notice by the half term holiday if you wish lessons to cease at the end of that term.

6. Parents should understand that the for their child to develop musically they must share some of this responsibility with the teacher. A keen interest in your child's progress is essential but firm encouragement to practise or “play” their instrument at a “special” time is just as important. Practice should be enjoyable and should never be thought of as a chore. I will be happy to discuss any problems or suggest practice routines to help with this. As your child progresses there will be music books to buy and accessories such as reeds, cleaning materials, music stands and at a later stage the possibility of up-grading mouthpieces and instruments. It may also be appropriate for your child to be entered for external exams and I will be happy to give advice on what may be helpful in due course.
